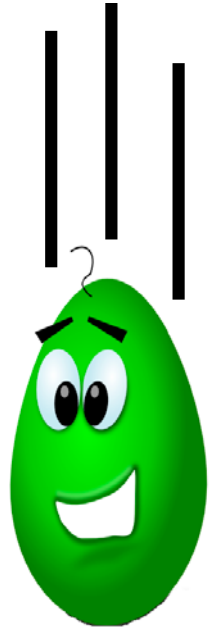


Newton's Egg

What's An Egg Drop?

Design a device to protect your egg from the sudden impact of a one or two story fall. Lightest and most accurate designs win trophies and prizes! Raw eggs provided by museum!

Who's Invited?

All schools with students who fit into one of these three categories: 1-2nd grade, 3-5th grade, 6-8th grade. Students may compete in teams or individually.

Where Is it Held?

The competition is held in the Cradle of Aviation's tiered atrium. Egg Drop Devices must be made PRIOR to the event, at home or at school. Design rules available on our website under Competitions.
